ARROWSTONE PARK BOARD TRAILS SUBCOMMITTEE

The Trails Sub-Committee met in regular session on Wednesday, August 15, 2018 at 10:30a.m. in the Hospital Board Room.

Agenda Item #1 – Call to Order

President Duncan called the meeting to order at 10:30am and with four members present, a quorum was established.

Agenda Item #2 – Approval of Minutes

Member Johnson motioned to approve the meeting notes from last meeting, June 20, 2018, with President Johnson seconding the motion. The Members approved the minutes by a vote of 4-0.

Agenda Item #3 – Johnson Creek Connector

Mr. Hamming discussed the improvements that had been made and the work remaining. Full Armor, a weed spraying company, was to take a pass along the trail on Friday the 10th, but Mr. Hamming had not yet received an update from Full Armor. Member Fischer was still working to coordinate with PCHS about having some football players help move some gravel to the north end of the trail. Mr. Hamming will work to draft up some signage that indicates that trail users should park near the restrooms if parking at Indian Creek Campground.

Agenda Item #4 – Old Yellowstone Trail

Mr. Hamming updated the Committee on the work of Phase I. The Committee also discussed the upcoming Open House on August 21st at the Community Center. The Committee discussed the types of questions to be considered as well as what the next steps will be following the Open House. Jerry Grebenc of Great West will be attending to offer assistance and help draft the management plan proposal. The Parks Board will be discussing additional details at their meeting on the 15th.
