Reports:

- Jodi reported on show camp and said they had a good turnout, it was very cold and rainy but otherwise everything went smoothly.
- Morgan and Taylor said they went to Blue Ribbon preview and showed, it was good with lots of animals.
- Jodi said there was a good turnout for the county event in Helmville. It was a leather working workshop. Travis Goettle did a really good job showing the kids about leather and let everyone practice on the leather as well.
- Sydney Reich was not in attendance so there was no report on 4-H Congress.
- Jodi said the 4-H Western Heritage Shooting National event was held in Deer Lodge, July 30-Aug 3. She helped with some of the logistics and Morgan, Sydney and Jesse also did the flag ceremony.
- Fair: Council did lunch again for clean-up day and we made \$345.00. Clubs donated items for the lunch so there were no expenses so it ended up being a good profit for the council. Zana felt fair went well except that we need to provide some training for new

people who sign up to be superintendents. There was a couple of issues in the chickens and rabbits and since the superintendent was new she didn't know how to handle some of the cases. Chad felt it was kind of unclear on the duties of Cream of the Crop corner as he thought they only needed to decorate but then were told they also needed to put item in there and arrange them and also put names on winners. This needs to be clarified better in the future.

Old Business:

- Leaders Forum will be in Dillon on September 28-29, 2018. Jodi encouraged leaders to attend since it was close and is hosted by our district. The district is looking for goody bag items and door prizes.
- Communications Rodeo: Zana said their club would like to host and it will tentatively be set for November 17 as that is in between sports. Jodi will ask Rick if we can use the high school for the event.
- Year End Celebration: Jodi said Last Chance will host this year. They are having games and food. Jodi Thomas had thrown out some dates for end of October, first part of November but nothing has been set yet.
- Record Book Contest: It was decided to split the record books into 4 divisions this year to make it more equal. Chad moved that the council give each winner in each category a \$35 gift certificate from Murdochs. Danielle seconded the motion. Motion passed.

New Business:

- Smile.Amazon.com donations: \$16.14 has been donated so far in one month which is figured at a ½ percent so that is \$3228 was purchased. Danielle said that she runs all of Fickler Oils purchases through this so that could be why we are seeing a good return.
- It was mentioned that there is a need for a couple of trophy sponsors: Hog Carcass trophy for \$20 and Champion Doe Rabbit for \$25.
